**We need help at the Expo.** : Wednesday morning is set-up at the fairgrounds in New Boston.

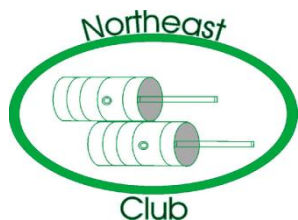
- We need 6 people at the auction to help on Friday and Sat.
