

**CLASSIC TRACTOR EXPO**  
**STOCK FARM TRACTOR PULLING RULES**  
**Saturday August 27, 2016**

**Superintendents:**

Mark Wilder, Rick Bowden

Weigh in and registration begins at 9:00 AM

Pull starts at 1:00 PM

Participants coming for the pull only, need to pay the gate fee of \$5.00 per person

No hitch fee for any weight class

Rosettes will be awarded to the top 4 places in each class

**General Rules:**

Operators must attend meeting at the scoring table at 12:00 Noon

Pull governed by 2 or more judges – all decisions final

No pit crew or operator coaching

No alcoholic beverages allowed

Violation of rules means disqualification

Safety is paramount covering all concerned

Good sportsmanship and common sense are always appreciated

No alternative fuels

Owner/operator will assume full responsibility for accidents

3 attempts for an 8' pull. 5 minute time limit

No jerk pulls

Any tractor being repaired or readied, misses its scheduled turn and pulls last

**Operators:**

Written permission of parent or guardian if operator is under 18 years old

No switching within or between classes

Must remain seated and in full control while pulling

Use caution backing up to stoneboat

No passengers at any time

Must stop on judges signal, be in neutral when hitching or unhitching with hands extended

**Tractors:**

Stock farm tractors, ag tread with forward rotation, or steel wheels

No cut or ground tires. No duals. No industrial or grader tires

No 4 wheel drives unless drive shaft is disconnected

Weight class is tractor with rider

Tractors may enter two weight classes only

Draw bar height is 20.5" max. No additional stabilization allowed

Standard straight or twist clevis (operator provided) must accept stoneboat chain hook

No other hook up is allowed

Governor bypass prohibited

Must have minimum 18" vertical exhaust or factory system

Must have working rear brakes

**Weight:**

All tractors must be weighed for each class it enters. Weighing begins at 9:00 AM

Tires may be loaded

All added weight must be securely attached to the wheels or frame

If added weight is lost during pull, the hitch is disqualified

**Pulling:**
