Directions to 223 North Road, Sunapee, NH:

- From Route 89 take exit 12, drive West approximately 6 miles to downtown Sunapee. Look for the Safety Services Building on right hand side of road with Smoky the Bear sign. Approximately 800 feet past the sign take a right onto Lower Main Street, drive about a quarter mile then take right onto North Road, drive 1 mile, the farm will be on your left. Look for the signs that say "Mowing Day".

- From Route 91 take exit 8, drive East on 103 through Claremont and Newport bearing left at traffic island onto RT.11. In center of Sunapee at blinking light take left onto Lower Main Street, drive approx. quarter mile then take right onto North Road, drive 1 mile, farm will be on your left. Look for the signs that say "Mowing Day".

A motion was made and seconded to accept the Secretary's report as printed in the newsletter. The motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was given by Leila McDanolds. Alan Rutherford did our non-profit income tax return this year and charged \$50.00. The current checking account balance is \$18,532.85 divided into the following accounts:

A motion was made and seconded to accept the Treasurer's report as presented. The motion passed.

Tom Miller gave a report on Expo V. It will be three full days. Thursday will be set-up. On Friday night there will be a country western concert sponsored by the 4-H Foundation. Saturday night will feature pulling. The event will conclude by 2:00pm on Sunday. The committee hopes to add tractor games for kids and possibly a youth tractor pull. We have three big sponsors so far. We have \$6000 so far, but we need \$8000 total in order to host the event. Jeryl Frankenfield made a motion to allow the Expo committee to use \$8,000 of club funds for Expo expenses. The motion was seconded, and passed.

Tom has Expo V business cards for members to pass out. Sponsors wishing to be included on the handouts need to have their papers in by the end of the month. They have until next year if they want to be on the t-shirts.

Next Saturday at 9:00am will be the Plow Day at Picnic Rock.

Duffy and Leila will not be hosting Plow Day next year. Members were asked to think of alternative locations for this annual event.

If members are interested in bringing a tractor or implement to display with the Club at the North Haverhill Fair the last week in July please contact Morty. Volunteers helping with this event we take turns manning the booth.

The club now has a Model 70 pedal tractor for this year's raffle as well as a four wheel drive pedal tractor for next year's raffle. It is currently being housed at Ralph Reed's house.

The McDanolds were thanked for hosting the club for today's event. Duffy was thanked for helping adjust plows for participating members.

The Canandaigua Expo will take place on July 7, 8, 9. We will have a club tent with Expo V handouts. Any and all members are invited to join in.

The next Club meeting and event will be on August 7th at Gordon Rampott's for Mowing Day.

A motion was made, seconded and passed to adjourn the meeting.

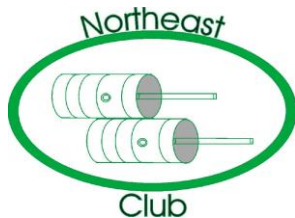
