Directions to 223 North Road, Sunapee, NH:

Approximately 800 feet past the sign take a right onto Lower Main Street, drive about a quarter mile then take right onto North Road, drive 1 mile, the farm will be on your left. Look for the signs that say "Mowing Day".

- From Route 91 take exit 8, drive East on 103 through Claremont and Newport bearing left at traffic island onto RT.11. In center of Sunapee at blinking light take left onto Lower Main Street, drive approx. quarter mile then take right onto North Road, drive 1 mile, farm will be on your left. Look for the signs that say "Mowing Day".

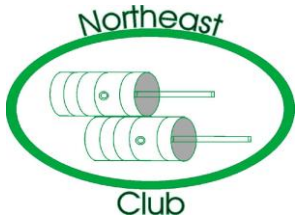
