### **Directions to 223 North Road, Sunapee, NH:**

- From Route 89 take exit 12, drive West approximately 6 miles to downtown Sunapee. Look for the Safety Services Building on right hand side of road with Smoky the Bear sign.

Approximately 800 feet past the sign take a right onto Lower Main Street, drive about a quarter mile then take right onto North Road, drive 1 mile, the farm will be on your left. Look for the signs that say "Mowing Day".

- From Route 91 take exit 8, drive East on 103 through Claremont and Newport bearing left at traffic island onto RT.11. In center of Sunapee at blinking light take left onto Lower Main Street, drive approx. quarter mile then take right onto North Road, drive 1 mile, farm will be on your left. Look for the signs that say "Mowing Day".

### Old Business:

Jeryl Frankenfield thanked the Work Crew who helped set up today's meeting and indicated they would continue to help after the meeting.

The members thanked Duffy and Lila McDanolds for hosting the Plow Day again this year.

Jeryl continued with a report on the Expo VI Committee's activities. They have had several meetings and are working with a budget estimate of \$7,500. He made a Motion to approve the Expo VI Budget of \$7,500 to be valid for 18 months, Seconded by Gary Phelps. The Motion passed.

Further discussion of the Expo Committee's activities included review of the reduced attendance at Expo V and the idea of partnering with "Red Power" (Farmall) to increase participation and resources. The 4H Club would get the Gate receipts and the advertising costs would be split. Increased marketing of the Expo will be facilitated by an individual identified with experience and resources.

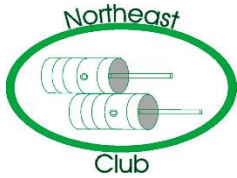
