President Morty Bailey called the meeting to order at 1:00pm.

A moment of silence was held in memory of Livona Allen.

A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the Secretary's report as written in the newsletter.

Leila McDanolds gave the following Treasurer's report:

The Treasurer also reminded members that if they do not pay their annual Club dues by January, they will be removed from the Club roster, and will not get a newsletter.

A motion was made, seconded, and passed to accept the Treasurer's report as presented.

Ralph Reed gave the nominating committee report. Listing that the President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer have all agreed to serve another year. With Hale Mattoon's term ending, he shall be replaced as Director by Jeryl Frankenfield, Sr. for a three-year term. Hale was thanked for his many years of service and support to the club. A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the slate of officers as presented.

There was discussion about needing more club volunteers to assist with the North Haverhill Fair in 2010. The club earned \$650 for their weeklong tractor display, and \$80 for participation in the parade.

Tom Miller reported on Expo IV. He suggested that posters and handouts be distributed now. The committee is still looking for belt-driven equipment to demonstrate at certain times of the day at the Expo.

The 4-H Foundation will have 80 beds available in the bunkhouse on a first come, first served basis. The cost is \$10 per night. Occupants are in charge of supplying their own sheets and towels.

Expo IV ads will start being run in January in the Green Magazine. Peggy and Tom Miller will promote the Expo at the "Gathering of the Green" in Moline in March.

The gates for Expo IV will open on Friday at noon; there will be 2 days of silent auctions, and pulling under the lights on Saturday. Some of the seminar topics lined up so far include: generators, coils, oils/greases, troubleshooting, and carburetors. History tours will take place throughout the weekend to inform visitors about some of the tractors. Volunteers are still needed to help. A script will be available for the tour guides, but it is anticipated that there will also be some adlibbing.

The next Expo committee meeting will be on January 10 at the Hanover Fire Station at 9:00. All are welcome to attend.

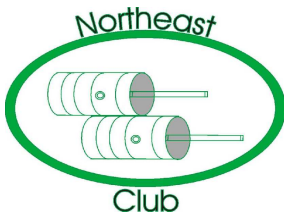

Dick Vaughan, winner of this year's drawing, gave his new pedal tractor to two of his great-granddaughters, Lizzie and Amy Vaughan.

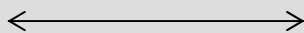
